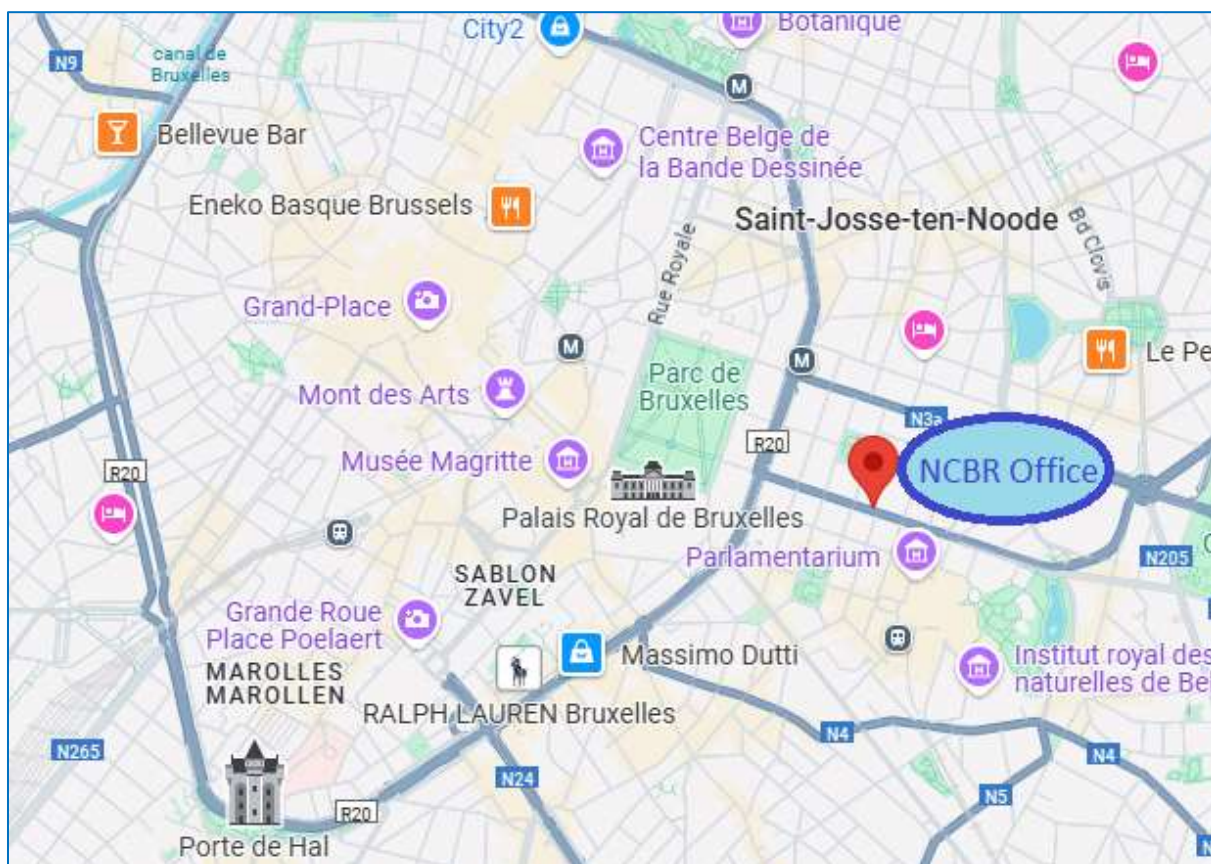

How to get there?

By Metro:

- Take **Line 2 or Line 6** and get off at **Trone station** (5-minutes' walk to the office).
- Alternatively, you can take **Line 1 or 5** and get off at **Maelbeek station** (10-min walk).

By Bus:

- Bus **Line 34** stops at Science station (5-minutes' walk to the office).
- Bus **Line 64 or 27** stop at TREVES station (5-minutes' walk to the office)

From Brussels Airport (BRU):

- Take **Train** to **Brussels Central Station** (approx. 20 min), then transfer to **Metro Line 1** towards **Stockel** and get off at **Schuman**. From there, it's a 10-minutes' walk.
- Take **Bus 12** to **Luxemburg station** (30 min) (5-minutes' walk to the office).
