





How to get there?

By Metro:

- Take Line 2 or Line 6 and get off at Trone station (5-minutes' walk to the office).
- Alternatively, you can take **Line 1 or 5** and get off at **Maelbeek station** (10-min walk).

By Bus:

- Bus Line 34 stops at Science station (5-minutes' walk to the office).
- Bus Line 64 or 27 stop at TREVES station (5-minutes' walk to the office)

From Brussels Airport (BRU):

- Take Train to Brussels Central Station (approx. 20 min), then transfer to Metro Line
 1 towards Stockel and get off at Schuman. From there, it's a 10-minutes' walk.
- Take **Bus 12** to **Luxemburg station** (30 min) (5-minutes' walk to the office).
